
WMUC 2020 - BULLETIN #2

G'day to all WFDF 2020 World Masters Ultimate Championships (WMUC) participating teams, WFDF member National Federations and Ultimate players around the world!

This WMUC 2020 Bulletin #2 is an update on how we're progressing with the tournament organisation and to highlight some updates to our schedule. These will affect all teams attending the WMUC 2020.

Confirmed Divisions:

At this point there are 4 confirmed divisions going ahead for WMUC:

- Master Women's
- Master Men's
- Master Mixed
- Grand Master Men's

ALL National Federations are welcome and encouraged to register a team in any/all of the above divisions.

NOTE: Countries that did not submit an initial EOI are still able to register and compete and are encouraged to do so. To register a team please contact Karina Woldt (karina.woldt@wfd.org) with WMUC Registration in the email subject heading.

The TOC will be accepting registration and team fee payments up until 30th November, 2019.

Possible extra divisions:

The TOC are still attempting to raise a handful of teams for the *Grand Master Mixed (GMX) Division*. This division requires a few more countries to become viable.

The TOC has re-opened Expressions of Interest for this division.

Any countries that are interested in sending a GMX participating team are invited to submit a new expression of interest.

Deadline for this EOI is 30th October, 2019.

Invoices for team fees will then be sent and payment of team fees will be by 30th November, 2019.

Payment and task schedule:

A number of nations requested extensions to pay team fees, and the hosts have granted this extension to all teams.

All team fees MUST be paid in full by 30th November, 2019.

This extension therefore imposes a number of other changes to the schedule. All team managers are required to read and act on the new deadlines for each of the various team and player registration tasks.

Participation Classification:

Players	<p>Competing in the event.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are registered on the WFDF player registration system. • Will receive Player lanyard and accreditation (pass).
Guests	<p>Includes all team staff (eg: Coaches, Team Managers, Trainers/Physiotherapists etc) as well as any supporters who are accredited with the team.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are registered on the WFDF Guest registration system • Will receive Guest lanyard and accreditation (pass). • Will attend any and all aspects of the event including social functions. • This can also include Juniors (under 18 years old) • Children under 8 years old are FREE
Spectators	<p>Are daily spectators who are welcome to attend some limited aspects of the event for a limited time.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are not registered on any registration system • Will be charged a daily ticket entry fee to enter the event venue and will receive a daily access ticket & wristband • Are unable to attend any of the social functions or post game activities. • Unable to access or use some of the event services eg: accommodation or shuttle services

National Federation to email copy of the payment receipt to TOC to confirm payment has been made.</p>	5 th February, 2020
Accommodation/shuttle and catering forms submitted	<p>Team Managers to complete online accommodation and catering booking forms (www.wmu2020.com/)</p> <p>*Forms will be available online in new event website which will be published in late Oct 2019.</p> <p>TOC will send an Invoice to the Team Manager/NF for accommodation/shuttle deposit (\$100AUD per person).</p>	18 th February, 2020

Payment of Accommodation, catering and shuttle deposits	Team Manager/National Federation to pay Accommodation/shuttle deposit (\$100AUD per person) (Team Manager to email confirmation of payment to TOC.	25 th February, 2020
Team to confirm final numbers of players and Guests	Final confirmation of Player and Guest numbers to be submitted by Team Managers to TOC.	15 th April, 2020
All final payments for accommodation and catering due.	Team Managers to pay any final player fees as well as all accommodation and catering fees for ALL participants (players and guests).	24 th April, 2020
Player briefing book released	This will outline all team and player registration requirements & event eligibility mandates.	June, 2020 (Date TBA)
