Event Dates

AAUC will be a four (4) day tournament. Friday 13th – Monday 16th October, 2023.

- Friday 13th October, 2023—Event registration, Captains & Spirit Captains Meetings, Opening Game and Ceremony
- Saturday 14th October, 2023— Round of games
- Sunday 15th October, 2023—Round of games, Semi finals
- Monday 16th October, 2023—Finals, Awards and Closing Ceremony

All teams are expected to attend the Captains' & Spirit Captains' meetings, as well as the opening ceremony which will be held in the afternoon day please plan your travel accordingly.

Should weather cause delays to play, the schedule will be adjusted accordingly to ensure the finals are played as scheduled.

Eligibility

Only teams from across the African continent are eligible to apply. The AAUC 23' is for National teams (max. one per country) and for club teams (unlimited per country), with each country allowed to pre-register and apply for multiple bids per division.

There is a requirement of at least 5 women on each roster, a minimum of 15 and maximum of 22 players per roster.

Please make note of the event deadlines as outlined below – failure to meet the deadlines could result in automatic loss of your team bid:

You are kindly asked to supply information and make payments <u>as soon as possible</u> – please do not wait until you are close to the deadline as this simply creates a bottleneck of work for WFDF and the LOC. We are not able to extend the deadlines nor make exceptions to the fees published – please do not ask.



Location & Venue

AAUC 2023 will be held in Kisumu, Kisumu County, Kenya. Kisumu is home to Kisumu Frisbee Club (Black Fish Ultimate) one of the oldest Frisbee clubs in Kenya. The city is the third largest city in Kenya, and is accessible by flight through Kisumu International Airport, by road or through Lake Victoria by water.

Opening games and final games will be held at the Jomo Kenyatta Stadium (WQJM+QFQ, Kisumu, Mamboleo Show ground, Kisumu). Other games will be held either in Kisumu Polytechnic (VQWF+P3 Kisumu) or Jaramogi Odinga Odinga Sports Ground (VQW3+RQR, Achieng' Oneko Rd, Kisumu).

Kisumu is a port city on Lake Victoria. It is a vibrant city with a diverse population and a thriving economy. The city is known for its lively markets, cultural events, and beautiful scenery, including stunning views of Lake Victoria. It is also a gateway to many of Kenya's top tourist destinations, including the Maasai Mara National Reserve and the Rift Valley.


While in Kisumu, be sure to try out some of the world famous locally prepared tilapia and ugali dish ;-)

Climate

Kisumu can get hot. Octobers typically averaging highs of 29°C and lows of 18°C, with a UV index average of 6.

The LOC where possible will ensure plenty of shade can be found for teams at each field as well as offering water stations in the field. The sun is expected to shine from 6am until 7pm daily with a 41% chance of patchy rain.

The LOC recommends players to consider bringing their sunscreen, sun glasses and hats, as well as refillable water bottles.



Accomodation

Transportation

Kisumu can be accessed by air, water or road. The infrastructure is pretty descent to get by.

Food

Lunch and water is included as part of the player fees, and will be provided to all teams at the designated serving booths in the fields.

There are also many options for food in restaurants within the city especially for your dinner options.

Visas

After your team has completed formal registration, it is important to inquire about obtaining the necessary visa to enter Kenya. Obtaining the correct documentation is your responsibility to visit Kenya and compete in AAUC 2023. The LOC can provide your team manager with a letter confirming your team's registration at the event. To do so, we require confirmation of the following details for all the members of your team: full name (as shown on passport), passport number, date of birth and role on team (i.e. player, coach, manager, etc).

Note: We cannot and will not provide a formal "invitation" to attend the event and inability to enter the Kenya is not grounds for a request of a refund for a team and/or player fees. We recommend EVERY TEAM makes specific inquiries and fully understand visa and travel requirements.

Health and Medical

Both WFDF and the LOC kindly request that all players and event participants recognize and accept the inherent risks associated with participating in AAUC, and acknowledge that WFDF and the LOC cannot be held accountable for any costs or risks associated with injury or poor health at the event. It is strongly recommended that all event participants take personal responsibility for their financial liability by acquiring their own travel and health insurance to ensure coverage in the event of any medical issues or event cancellations that may occur. Playing ultimate comes with a risk of injury. Throughout AAUC will have medical staff on site to deal with first aid and assess critical injuries, there however may be injuries or illness in which players need medical attention that requires emergency visits to local hospitals.



Cancellation Policy

In light of events witnessed during the Covid-19 pandemic, forces of nature can interfere with event implementation. Should the event need to be canceled, as determined by WFDF in consultation with LOC, the following cancellation terms will apply to all event fee payments:

Cancellation announced 5th July - 15th August 2023: 60% Fees collected will be returned.

Cancellation announced 16th August - 30th September 2023: 20% of Fees collected will be returned.
