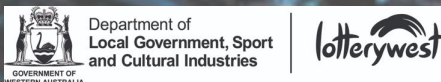
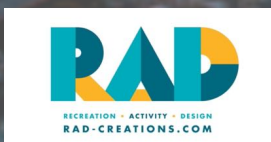

The World Flying Disc Federation (WFDF) and the Local Organising Committee (LOC) Mundaring Sporting Club Disc Golf, are excited to host you all at the WFDF 2024 World Team Disc Golf Championship (WTDGC) to be hosted in Mundaring, east of Perth, Western Australia next week.

On the road to WTDGC in Mundaring, Perth, please read the following information carefully. This is final information to help with your arrival to Perth.

The WTDGC will be hosted over 4 days from Wednesday 6th of November to Saturday 9th November on two 18-hole courses located in the bush and throughout the Mundaring Sporting Club Golf course.

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SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Tournament Dates

WTDGC will be a four (4) day tournament from Wednesday 6th to Saturday 9th November, 2024 inclusive. Should weather cause delays to play, the schedules will be adjusted accordingly to ensure the final is played as scheduled on day 4 or prior. The medal ceremony will follow immediately after the conclusion of the final game.

Practice

Official practice on both courses will be available Sunday 3rd, Monday 4th and Tuesday 5th November. All team captains have had the opportunity to pre-book practice time slots. You are welcome to practice on the course before and after scheduled practice times without a booking.

Practice will take place on both 18-hole courses so that teams may learn both the Mundaring Original Course and World Course as well as the 9-hole loops on both courses for Round 1 of the competition. Teams are kindly requested to arrive and be ready to practice on-time with your booked appointment. Late arrival could mean a shorter practice session or missing some holes along the way.

There will be no food or drinks available for purchase at the Mundaring venue during practice days. Please make your own arrangements (there are multiple food options in the town centre which is a 3 minute drive/ 15 minute walk from the tournament venue). See the WTDGC24 website for local food options and special offers.

During practice - toilets will be available downstairs in the Mundaring DG Club-house (near the club car park and Mundaring Original course - Hole 18.) There are also two portable toilets available on each of the courses.

Tap water in Australia is potable - there will also be three (3) filtered water outlets at the club grounds for filling your water bottles. Two outlets will be available upstairs near the bowling greens and one temporary outlet downstairs near Hole 1. Participants are kindly asked to bring a FULL water bottle with you to the fields each day - that will relieve some of the work the volunteers have to do.

The Mundaring Disc Golf Club-rooms will be open at limited times throughout practice. Please be respectful to our hosts and only access during open hours (signage will be posted at the entrance).

Teams will parade from the Shire of Mundaring Council, across the road (traffic marshals will assist), and down the Munda Biddi Heritage Trail to Sculpture Park.

A traditional custodian smoking ceremony will be conducted by a Noongar Aboriginal elder before teams are directed to sit before the stage for the Opening Ceremony.

The ceremony should be completed by 18:30, after which players are welcomed back to the Tournament Venue, Mundaring Sporting Club, for the Opening Player Party.

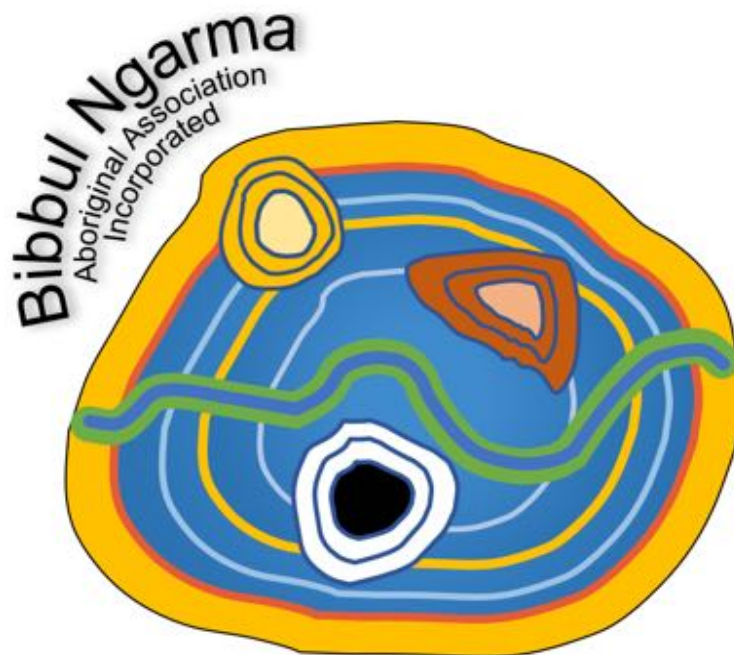

HEALTH & MEDICAL

All event participants and spectators travelling with the team are recommended to obtain travel insurance prior to booking flights and health insurance before leaving your home country.

The Australian healthcare system for visitors is based on individuals carrying personal insurance. WFDF and the LOC do not provide coverage for participants outside of the general first aid administered at the course. There are always risks associated with playing Disc Golf and travelling internationally. There may be injuries or illness in which players need medical attention that requires emergency visits to local hospitals.

Event participants are reminded that if you are feeling unwell, you should isolate yourself until your symptoms are clear. Please be fair to your teammates and other participants and recognise if you are unwell -do not come to the course.

For Medical and health supplies during the week (7 days 8am -7pm)- you can visit the Amcal+ Pharmacy in Mundaring 4/5 Nicol Street which closes at 7pm daily

Please reach out to WFDF should you have any questions around medical.

Participants are advised to take essential precautions regarding sun care, sunburn, and heat stroke due to extended daylight hours and high UV levels in November. Key recommendations include applying broad-spectrum sunscreen of SPF 30 or higher, wearing protective clothing and hats, seeking shade during peak UV hours between 10 AM and 4 PM, and staying hydrated by drinking water only from designated safe sources.

Please keep an eye on your teammates and recognise and prevent sunburn and heat stroke and understand the importance of immediate action and awareness of medical costs for international visitors.

AUSTRALIAN WILDLIFE

Participants are encouraged to follow essential guidelines on environmental stewardship and local wildlife safety. Key recommendations include staying on designated paths to protect sensitive ecosystems, properly disposing of waste and recycling to preserve the area's natural beauty, and avoiding feeding or approaching wildlife to prevent disrupting their natural behaviours. The region is home to venomous snakes and spiders; if encountered, remain calm, do not approach, and follow first aid procedures if bitten. To prevent tick and mosquito bites, wear long sleeves and pants, use insect repellent, and check for ticks after being in bush areas. Observe local fauna like kangaroos, emus, lizards, and cockatoos from a distance to minimise disturbance. For detailed information on these guidelines and how to comply, please refer to the full document.

Participants are also encouraged to ensure your footwear is very clean when arriving in Australia - biosecurity is strict and they will check and clean your shoes - but there will be a charge if you don't declare them as soiled articles. Please also note not to bring any food (honey, meats, cheeses, fruits, nuts etc) into Australia - failure to declare will be an immediate infringement with fine.

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Participants should be aware of important guidelines regarding alcohol and smoking laws, as well as PDGA and WFDF regulations. Key points include the legal drinking age of 18, prohibitions on consuming alcohol in public spaces, strict drink-driving laws with severe penalties, and smoking bans in enclosed and certain outdoor public areas.

Both the PDGA and WFDF have rules prohibiting alcohol consumption and smoking during events to promote fair play and a positive environment. Violations can result in penalties or disqualification.



EVENT FACILITIES

Club Bar and Coffee/Food

The Mundaring Sporting Club will have a Bar, and Food and Coffee facility for WTDGC24 participants, staff, volunteers and all spectators, located inside the club rooms, upstairs and opposite the bowling greens. The Bar/Food/Coffee will be next to the Player/VIP Lounge, which will be for players, staff, volunteers and VIPs only.

Toilets

- Men's and women's toilets, showers and change rooms (downstairs near Mundaring Original course Hole 18 basket)
- Men's and women's toilets upstairs, inside the club rooms
- Portable toilets on the course (two on each course)

We will have caterers for breakfast and lunch on competition days. You will be sent a link to order breakfast and lunch items.

WTDGC24 Market

There will be a market setup near the practice areas and first holes of both courses. The market will have various stalls including local produce, discs, merch and tourism information on different days. Food trucks and an extra coffee van will be available on some days in the Market.

WTDGC24 Bar and Coffee/Food, and Player-VIP Lounge

The WTDGC24 Bar and Coffee/Food will be open on Competition days, serving coffee, hot food, snacks, and alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages. Local cafe Red Tails will be set up in the Venue kitchen providing paninis and other food, with breakfast and lunch options for players and spectators. The WTDGC24 Bar and Coffee/Food will be open to all at WTDGC24. The Player-VIP Lounge will be located in the same area, but roped off for access only to players and guests, their families, staff, volunteers and [spectators](#) with a VIP pass.

TICKETS & SPECTATORS

We will be inviting spectators to come and watch WTDGC24 and enjoy the thrill of world teams disc golf. General Admission spectator tickets are free. Limited VIP tickets include VIP Venue and Parking access, and options for VIP meals and a drink, and a showbag. **Tickets are available [at this link](#)**. Please note parking for players, guests and volunteers will be located at Mundaring Arena, with the parking area on Coolgardie Street reserved for people with disabilities, event staff and VIPs (subject to change). Player-VIP lounge area will be reserved for players and guests (non playing support) and their families and friends, people with disabilities, event staff, volunteers and VIPs. People using the VIP areas will need appropriate accreditation.

- Tipping is not mandatory but appreciated for exceptional service
- Respect Indigenous culture by acknowledging traditional landowners and observing guidelines when visiting culturally significant sites
- Social norms like friendly greetings, queuing etiquette, and punctuality
- Local laws regarding road safety, pedestrian rules, waste disposal, smoking, and alcohol consumption
- Practical information on public holidays, weather, public transport, emergency services, currency, and connectivity.

What to pack

Weather - dress for warm to hot weather. Wear sun-protective clothing such as long sleeved shirts, arm protection sleeves, and a hat. Sunscreen will be available at the Tournament Venue.

Shoes - closed shoes for play, open shoes OK otherwise. Thongs or flip-flops are usually not permitted in licensed venues (pubs, taverns, restaurants).

PARKING & LOCAL TRANSPORT

Practice day, competition day and social event parking will be available at Mundaring Arena, 50 Mundaring Weir Road, with some limited parking also at the Tournament Venue on Coolgardie Street (for staff, people with disabilities and VIPs). Access to the course and Tournament Venue from Mundaring Arena car park is about 5 minutes walk. Ensure you follow the marked route from Mundaring Arena car park to the Tournament Venue, Mundaring Sporting Club, where you'll find Tee 1 for both courses, and the WTDGC24 Food and Bar and Market zones.
